P3 Snapshot: **Alaska**

SUMMARY OF P3 LEGISLATIVE STATUS:

Alaska is not currently enabled for Public-Private Partnerships.

1. Does this state have broadly enabling P3 legislation?
Formerly had P3 procurement authority specific to Knik Arm Bridge. Neither municipal facilities (social, vertical, people-centered, buildings, community-use) nor environmental projects are addressed in the context of Alaska's statutory authority.
2. Does the state allow for **Unsolicited Proposals**?
There are no apparent provisions to consider or accept unsolicited proposals.
3. What is the state's P3 **Review Process**?
In addition to reporting, the state requires state legislative approval of any P3 initiative.
4. Does the state have a **Centralized Agency** dedicated to P3?
Knik Arm Bridge and Toll Authority had served as the centralized authority.
5. Is this a **Home Rule state**, with limitations or opportunities for P3?
Broad governmental authority is in place for public works procurement.
6. Does this state have programmatic requirements for P3 participation (ie MWDBE or labor)?
The state's bonding requirements for public works procurements are listed in the state's Little Miller Act. Compliance with mandates for funding and financing resources govern DBE participation.
7. Are P3 projects in this state eligible for other financing programs?
TIFIA financing is allowable for state transportation projects, as well as combination of local, state, federal and/or private funds for eligible transportation projects. There are no restrictions which prohibit access to WIFIA for applicable water projects.
8. What Projects or Asset Classes are eligible for P3 in this state?
Alaska has Design + Build authority in place which permits all agencies for all types of design and construction projects, including transportation. Previous P3-enabling authority had applied to transportation (the Knik Arm Bridge).
9. Are there Projects where the P3 procurement method has been applied?
Knik Arm Bridge.
10. What is the legislative foundation for P3s in this state?
